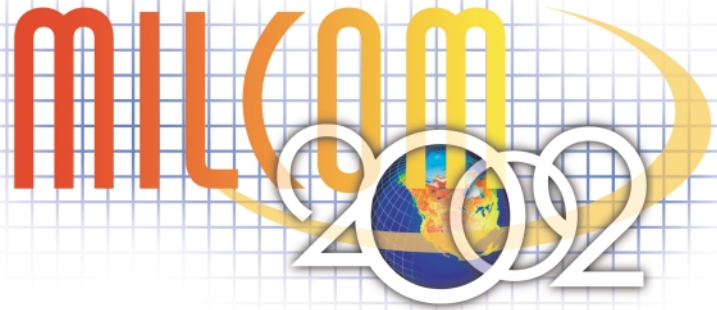

Classified papers are accepted up to the level of SECRET. Approval for foreign disclosure is recommended for all unclassified and classified papers. After review and acceptance of abstract, final selection for inclusion in the program will be based on draft papers.
