Vice Admiral Nancy E. Brown serves as the Director for Command, Control, Communications and Computer Systems (C4 Systems), The Joint Staff. As the J-6, Admiral Brown is the principal advisor to the Chairman, Joint Chiefs of Staff on all C4 systems matters within the Department of Defense. Prior to her current position, she was the Director of Command Control Systems, Headquarters North American Aerospace Defense Command, and Director of Architectures and Integration, Headquarters U.S. Northern Command. Previous positions include the first Multi-National Force Iraq C6 Headquartered in Baghdad; Vice Director for Command, Control, Communications, and Computer Systems (J6), The Joint Staff; Deputy Director and Fleet Liaison, Space, Information Warfare, Command and Control (N6B); Deputy Director, White House Military Office; and Com-

mander, Naval Computer and Telecommunications Area Master Station Atlantic. Admiral Brown holds a bachelor's degree from Stephens College, a master of science degree in communications systems management from the Naval Postgraduate School, and a master of arts degree in national security and strategic studies from the Naval War College. Her follow-on assignment was as the Officer in Charge.
