Director, Network Services, DISA

Cindy E. Moran is the Chief, Center for Network Services, and is responsible for managing the operations of the Defense Information Systems Network (DISN).

Ms. Moran is the architect of the recent Enhanced Planning Process (EPP) that overhauled the entire subscription chart for users of the DISN. In addition, Ms. Moran served as the Vice Director of the Strategic Planning and Information Directorate, where she supported the DISA Director in decision making and strategy development, and communicating that strategy both internally and externally, aligning DISA program execution with Department of Defense (DoD) strategy in planning, engineering, acquir-

ing, fielding and supporting global net-centric solutions, operating the Global Information Grid, information assurance and management of DISA information technology resources.

Prior to assuming this position, she was the Chief, Data Services Division. In that role, Ms. Moran was charged with the evolution of DoD's operational networks. She was responsible for the design, procurement, engineering and implementation plans, as well as the actual installation of the equipment in the networks. Before joining DISA, she held multiple positions in support of DoD Information Technology systems, to include hands-on network and system administration jobs. This hands-on experience at every level of implementation; operation, management, performance and security has provided a sound foundation and comprehensive knowledge of the dependencies of information systems and how to insure that these dependencies are all accommodated for in any information system implementation.

She received her undergraduate degree in Information Systems Management from the University of Maryland, European Division, in July 1988. She received her graduate certificate in Information Security Management from George Washington University in August 2002.
