Executive Director, C2 Integration Division, U.S. Marine Corps Combat Development Command

Mr. Marty Westphal is the executive director, Command and Control Integration Division, Capability Development Directorate, Marine Corps Combat Development Command, Quantico, Virginia. His primary role as the executive director is in serving as the executive agent for Command and Control Capability Portfolio Management and as the key liaison and advocate for Marine operating forces determining and developing command and control capabilities and enhancements. This ensures the capabilities are translated and integrated into the Marine Corps' requirements and resource allocation systems. He oversees the division's role identifying shortfalls in warfighting capabilities, developing and executing near-term and long-term solutions enhancing Marine Corps command and control capabilities. His responsibilities include integrating capability shortfalls identified through the Joint Capabilities Integration and Development System into the DoD requirements, resource allocation, and acquisition systems. As the Marine Air Ground Task Force Command and Control overseer he ensures existing and planned command and control systems are synchronized to achieve command and control interoperability and integration objectives as outlined in the Marine Corps Combat Development Command Campaign Plan and the Commandant Marine Corps Planning Guidance. Mr. Westphal is also responsible for all operational architecture development supporting the Marine Corps.



Mr. Westphal is a retired Marine Corps Officer. Commissioned in 1978, he served in a variety of command and staff billets over his military career, including operational experience in Desert Shield and Desert Storm. His military education includes the Armor Officer Basic and Advanced Courses, Marine Aviation and Weapons Tactics Squadron One Instructor Course, Distinguished Graduate of the USMC Command and Staff College, and the USMC School of Advanced Warfighting.

Mr. Westphal's Joint and Combined service includes assignments as a Combatant Command Liaison Officer at the Joint Warfare Analysis Center, Naval Surface Warfare Center, Dahlgren, Virginia. Mr. Westphal's subsequent billets included Operational Integration Team Chief, and Plans Division Head, Plans and Policy Directorate.
