Mark Gungoll is deputy transition manager for the TSP JCTD supporting the Global Broadcast Service Joint Program Office (GBS JPO). TSP explores commercial technologies to extend robust communications and improve information sharing across the tactical edge of the battlespace, and specifically looks to GBS as the target for technology transition.

Gungoll has also supported the National Geospatial-Intelligence Agency (NGA) as the Research and Development (R&D) Program Director of the Chemical, Biological, and Radiological-arm of the National Technology Alliance. Under his direction, more than 60 projects have been executed that harness commercial industry's ability to rapidly contribute to the nation's R&D needs.

Prior to entering industry, Gungoll was a career Naval Officer, serving 28 years in operational intelligence, program management, and staff positions with the U.S. Navy, NATO, the NRO and the Joint Staff. His last tour was with the Joint Staff J2 as director for assessments, doctrine, requirements and capabilities.
