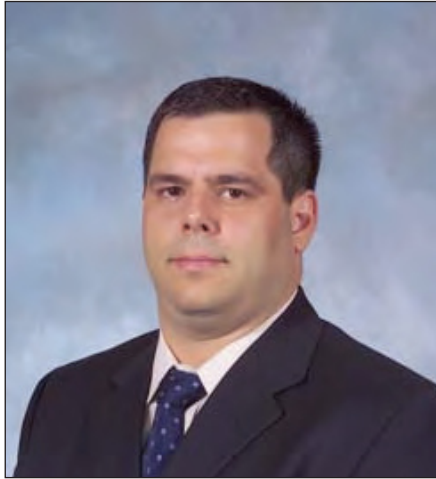




## Jon Keller

Jon Keller is the Deputy Director of CERDEC's S&TCD. In this capacity, he leads an organization to initiate, develop, and integrate technologies and solutions that support Army and Joint warfighters. In addition the Directorate's tech base mission, he ensures the organization provides effective engineering support to the acquisition community.

Keller has achieved success in various technical and leadership positions in both government and private industry settings. Since 2002, he has worked in the CERDEC, most recently leading S&TCD's tactical radio branch. In that capacity, Keller worked to initiate and develop several technology insertion products for major acquisition programs. He also led the concept refinement and initiation of CERDEC's waveform assessment, porting, and integration laboratory, a facility for evaluating and better understanding the processes associated with integrating hardware and software elements of software defined radios.

Prior to joining the Department of Defense, Keller served in a variety of engineering, leadership, and project management capacities, both in large enterprise and small start up corporate environments. In late 2001, he worked for a large telecommunications firm in Manhattan implementing communications and networking solutions to ensure post-9/11 continuity of operations for various Wall Street financial institutions.

Keller is a 2008 graduate of the Army War College, Carlisle, Pa., and a Harvard University JFK School of Government Senior Executive Fellow. He holds a bachelor's degree in electrical engineering from the Colorado School of Mines and a master's degree in strategic studies from the Army War College.
