Kris Osborn is a staff writer (land warfare) for *Defense News*. He joined *Defense News* in November 2006, arriving with a wealth of experience in print and broadcast journalism. Osborn covers Land War trends, developments, technologies and weapons; he has often appeared live on MSNBC to discuss MRAP vehicles, robots and missile defense issues.

In 2004, he embedded with the U.S. Army's 1st Infantry Division and reported from Iraq, filing dispatches and photographs for the *Washington Times*. Osborn gave a presentation on modernizing battle command in June at the IDGA's force tracking and combat ID conference.

From 2001 to 2004, Osborn worked at CNN's Atlanta headquarters as a reporter, anchor, military analyst and columnist. He frequently anchored broadcasts at CNN/U.S. and *CNN Headline News*. As *CNN Headline News*' military specialist, he anchored special segments, including daily live reports and interviews with military experts. He also reported from the Pentagon and other U.S. military installations. And he wrote a weekly column, "Target Terrorism," for CNN.com.

Before CNN, Osborn covered national politics and general assignment stories for Fox News' print and video outlets; and before that, he was a reporter and anchor for Primedia's Channel One, a news program for secondary schools.

Osborn earned a master's degree in English and comparative literature from Columbia University and a bachelor's degree in English and political science from Kenyon College.
