Charles 'Chuck' Pizzutelli has over 35 years of military communications and applications experience and has been a member of the Program Executive Officer, Command, Control and Communications Tactical (PEO C3T) since its inception in 1987, the organization responsible for development, acquisition and fielding for nearly all command and control and communications systems for tactical echelons of the US Army. He is currently serving as the Deputy PEO for this \$2B/year organization, headquartered at Ft Monmouth, NJ with major elements in Ft Belvoir, Huntsville and Aberdeen Proving Ground. One of his primary responsibilities is the relocation of the organization to APG in accordance with BRAC 2005. From 1997 till mid-2008, he served at the Chief Engineer for PEO C3T, thereby responsible for the system engineering and integration of the PEO's portfolio of battle command, network and enabler products in support of US Army organizations worldwide. He has been very active in the US Army's digitization and transformation initiatives. Assignments prior to joining the PEO included Interoperability Engineer for Project Manager, Mobile Subscriber Equipment and Project Leader/Engineer for numerous lower level programs.



His government service includes over 10 years of active military time as an officer of the Signal Corps with assignments at Ft Huachuca, Ft Gordon and in Korea.

He holds a BS degree in mathematics/computer science and an MS in computer science from Carnegie Mellon University.
